

Germany - PT Dresden-Nuernberg



Lush German countryside is painstakingly detailed to depict this beautiful line. Green trees recede into the hills, rows of houses and buildings line the countryside, and expertly laid track with overhead power lines make for a breathtaking route.

This route itself contains a number of original and interesting sessions, ranging from modern regional and local freight, to passenger services aboard the famous InnerCityExpress (ICE) tilt train.

Many of the freight sessions revolve around the local Brewery, with tasks ranging from delivering the Barley, to delivering the beer to a local event which is running dry!

This demo contains a 7km route linking the Tharandt and Dresden-Plauen together through a series of small towns booming with industry. A narrated Introduction Ride detailing the workings of the German signal system is also included.

This is a section of the full route to be released later in the year by Blue Sky Interactive who aim to deliver a range of professional Trainz addons.
